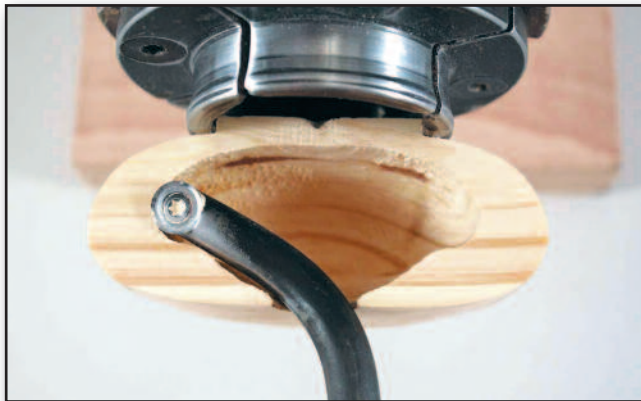
These steps show the use of the *Hunter* tools from the inside. Then the following steps will elaborate and show these procedures from the outside.



Start by using the *Hunter* 3/8" straight tool. Make a series of cuts starting at the opening and going back until the back of the 5/8" hole is reached.



This is then followed by using the 5/16" swan neck tool, which will reach the area at the front curve of the ornament body.



Next, with the *Hunter* 3/8" swan neck tool, make a series of cuts starting at the opening again and going back until the back of the 5/8" hole is reached.



Finally, the 3/8" swan neck tool is used again to make the finishing cuts, cutting from the back of the body to the center. Use a thickness gauge often while working with any of the *Hunter* tools to prevent cutting through the side of the ornament body.



Then use the small *Hunter* 3/16" tool to hollow inside the 5/8" opening as far as it will reach.
