

Tools For Sale by Pam Reilly, a former Club Member

As you may already know, I am leaving woodturning and selling off the contents of my shop (non-health related). I realize that many of you don't know me and some of you might not remember me, and thought I should (re)introduce myself. My name is Pam Reilly and I live in Elgin, MN. I spent many happy years as a member of CRW - two of which I co-chaired as Program Director and another two I was Treasurer. I demoed my box-making techniques and delved into how I make hollow forms with a mosaic motif. Those of you who do know me, know that I am pretty meticulous about my work and about my equipment. 
Please see Duane Hill if you are interested in any of these items. He will not have at the meeting, but you can make arrangements to see them.


Next Meeting Saturday, May 16 2015 at 9 am.
